Jan Hus (1369 - 1415)

- wanted to elect bishops not appointed
- caused consternation
- made his case, but he was found to be a HERETIC

John Wycliffe (1324 - 1384)

- Interpreted in the Aquinianity at the church
- People should live close to God and interpret the Bible on their own
- Lived during the Western Schism
- ↳ Ignition caused papacy and anti-popes
- ↳ caused questioning/doubt about papal authority.
- Early Bibles



Scotland - John Knox - Presbyterians

- Calvinism (so many uses...)



- * Results of the Counter-Reformation:
 - restores the Catholic Church, like the Jesuits, were often (no more parties)
 - follows to, reacts to the first reformation
 - (cancel of respect for Luther) much faster under the harsh new leaders
 - church had to accept the division of Europe, which became stronger in the areas it still existed.
